

TREATMENTS COMMONLY PERFORMED BY PEDIATRIC PROVIDERS:

- Provide preventative health care services
- Perform physical examinations at the time intervals recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP)
- Providing current vaccinations as well as recommendations provided by the AAP and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC)
- Monitoring developmental milestones
- Manage physical, mental and emotional well-being of their patients throughout all stages of development
- Diagnosing and treating acute and chronic illnesses
- Diagnosing and treating injuries within the scope of their expertise
- Educating parents about proper child care
- Informing/educating parents about changes in AAP policies/guidelines regarding child care
- Addressing questions or concerns from parents about child development regardless of age of the child
