TREATMENTS COMMONLY PERFORMED BY PEDIATRIC PROVIDERS:

- -Provide preventative health care services
- -Perform physical examinations at the time intervals recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP)
- -Providing current vaccinations as well as recommendations provided by the AAP and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC)
- -Monitoring developmental milestones
- -Manage physical, mental and emotional well-being of their patients throughout all stages of development
- -Diagnosing and treating acute and chronic illnesses
- -Diagnosing and treating injuries withing the scope of their expertise
- -Educating parents about proper child care
- -Informing/educating parents about changes in AAP policies/guidelines regarding child care
- -Addressing questions or concerns from parents about child development regardless of age of the child
